

## **Hon. Victor O. Frazer, Esq.**

Victor O. Frazer has served at the highest levels of government in the United States. Elected as a Member of Congress in the 104th Congress of the United States, Mr. Frazer represented the U.S. Virgin Islands. He served on the House Foreign Affairs Committee and the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs.

In Congress, Vic Frazer was a staunch political independent, working cooperatively with both Republican and Democratic parties. Widely traveled, Mr. Frazer has represented the United States Government at a number of international conventions, and has been an official election observer of the historic elections in the former Soviet Union and elections in Asia, Latin America, Africa, and the Newly Independent States (NIS) of the former Soviet Union(Russia)

Prior to his election to Congress, Mr. Frazer served as the Senior Counsel to the District of Columbia Committee, Subcommittee on Judiciary and Education. He also served as Chief Counsel to U.S. Representative Mervyn M. Dymally, Chairman of the Subcommittee on Africa and the Subcommittee on International Operations. Additionally, he was Special Assistant Counsel to U.S. Representative John Conyers, Jr. (D-MI), Chair of the House Judiciary Committee. After Congress, Mr. Frazer was a senior advisor to the President and an assistant to the Secretary of Veteran's Affairs. At the request of the Governor, Mr. Frazer accepted the position as General Counsel to the U.S. Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority, where he served for two years.

Mr. Frazer began his legal career with the Interstate Commerce Commission, the precursor to the Department of Transportation, and then he was drawn to public service as a Reginald Heber Legal Fellow with the Community Legal Services in the U.S. Virgin Islands and later in Washington, D.C. Upon completion of the fellowship, he joined the Department of Commerce as an Attorney-Examiner in the Office of Patent and Trademark. After leaving the Patent Office, Frazer spent several years as an Assistant Attorney General for the District of Columbia.

He is a member of the Bar of the District of Columbia, Maryland State Bar, New York State Bar, and the U.S. Virgin Islands Bar. He is also admitted to practice before the United States Court of Customs and Patent Appeals and the United States Court of Appeals for the Armed Forces. He received an A.B. from Fisk University and a J.D. from Howard University School of Law.
