Dear Mr. Gray:

I represent Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. in its corporate capacity. In that connection I have been asked to contact you concerning your August 11, 2009 letter to Aaron Handleman, who is handling the defense of the above referenced litigation, concerning the wrongful disclosure of what appears to be the confidential financial information of the Sorority.

Your letter suggests that Mr. Handleman and the Sorority's insurers should somehow interject themselves into the daily operation of the Sorority, and that by initiating this lawsuit the plaintiffs can bring the operation of the Sorority to a halt during the pendency of the litigation. That will not happen.

AKA is a multimillion dollar business, and will continue to conduct its daily business consistent with its policies and procedures, and all applicable laws and rules. Neither you nor the eight plaintiffs in this case can prevent the Sorority from conducting its business. Nor will you prevent Barbara McKinzie from carrying out the direction of the Board of Directors or from pursuing her mission to build and improve the Sorority.


Your letter speaks of irreparable injury. The only irreparable injury is being inflicted on the Sorority by you and your clients by bringing this frivolous lawsuit and then attempting to litigate it in the media. The Sorority will not imitate those tactics.
